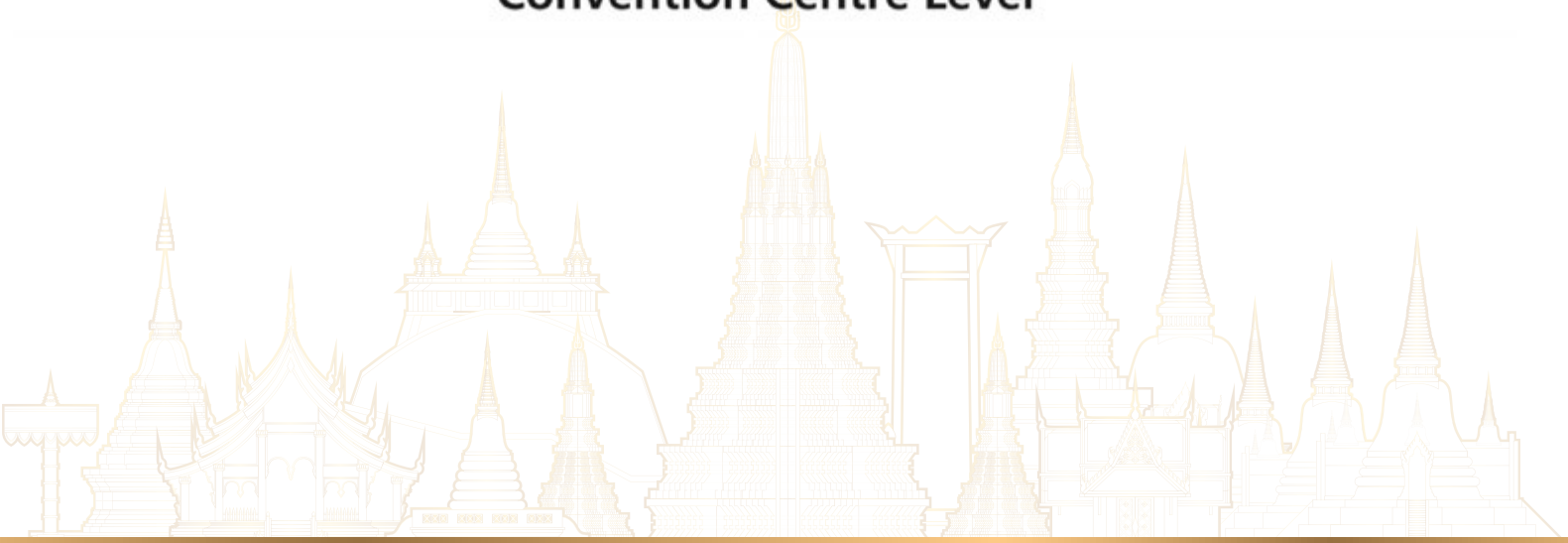




# Venue Floor Plan

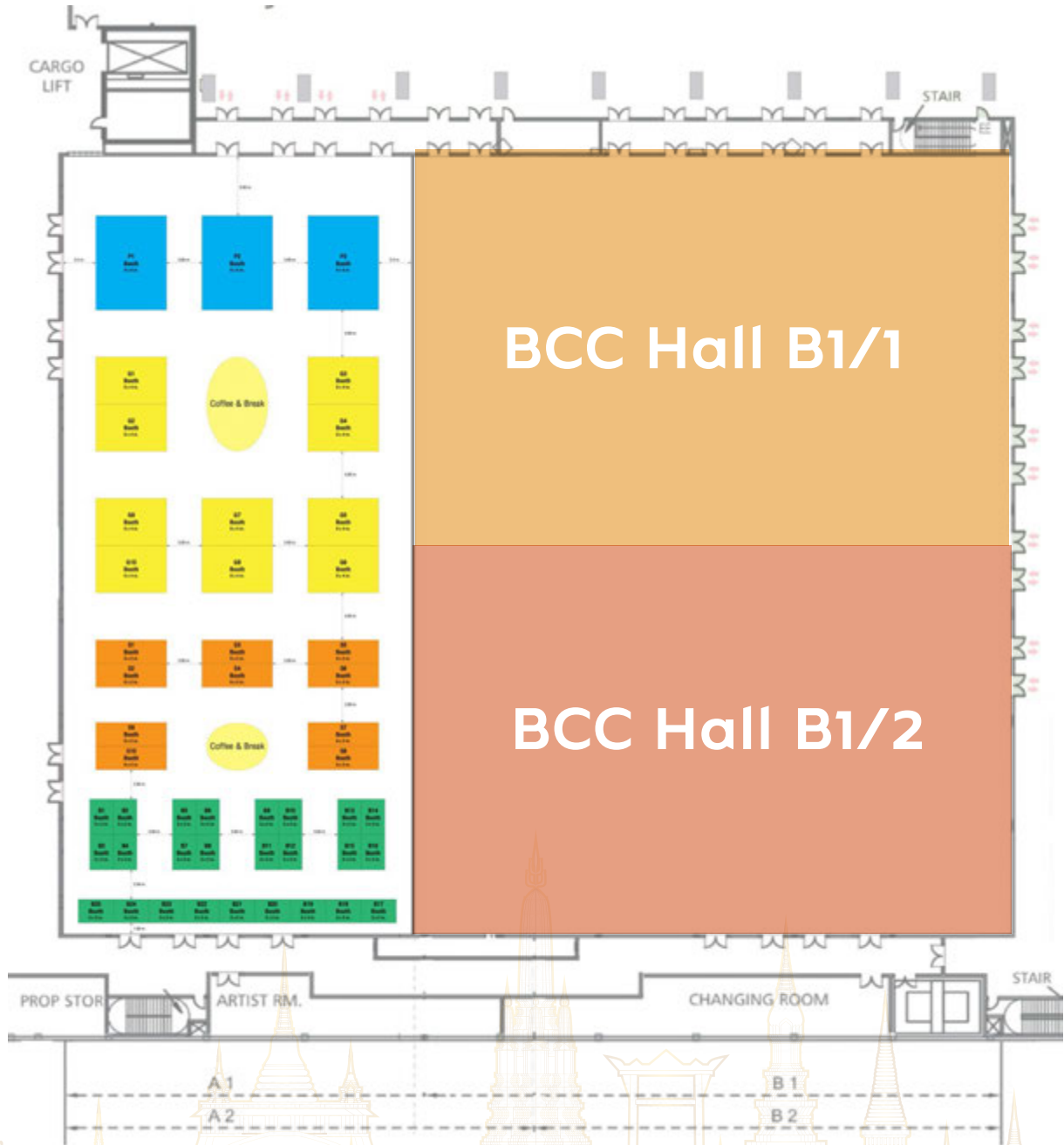


## Convention Centre Level



# Exhibition Floor Plan

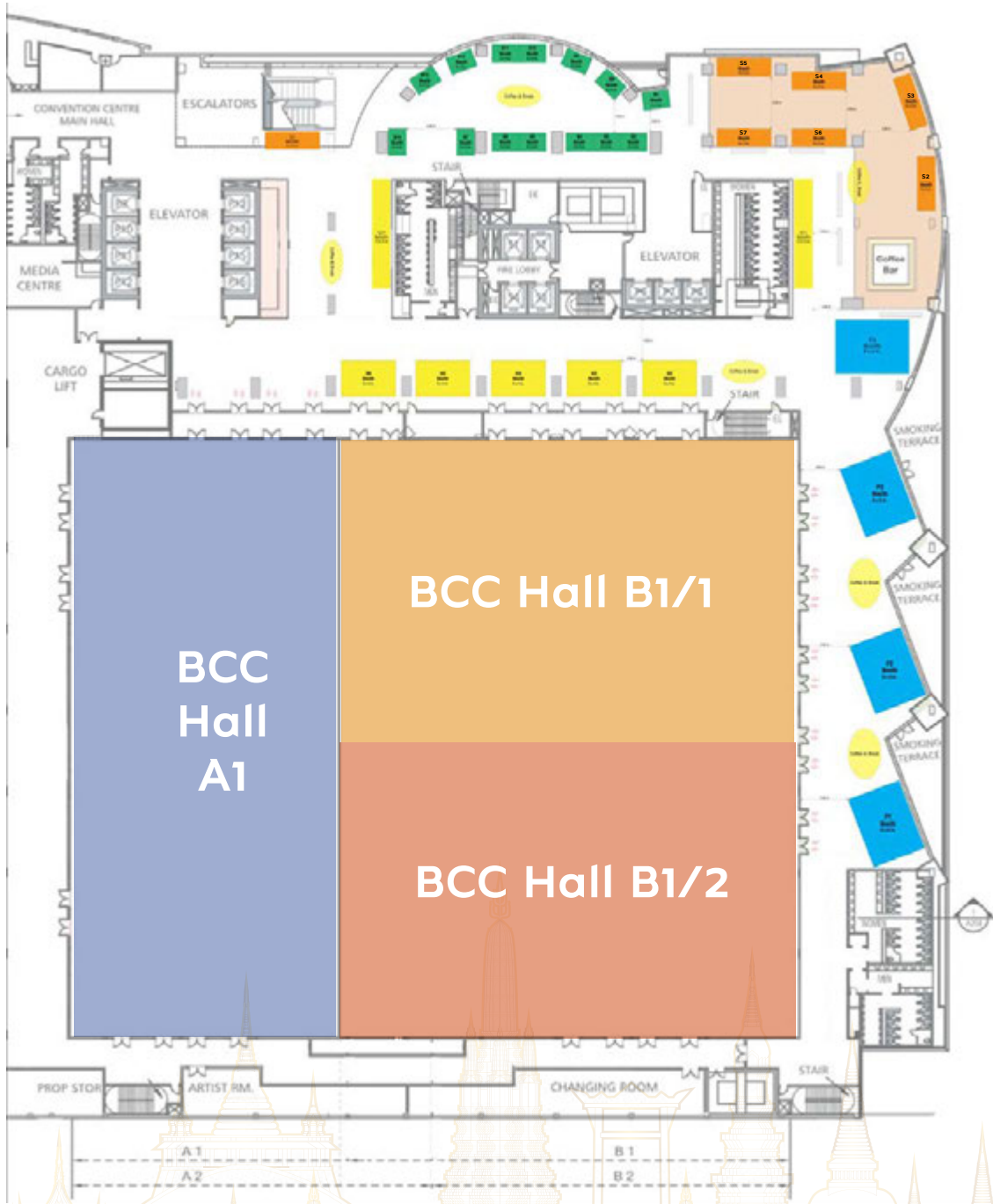
